Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Severus Alexander mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r. Graffito x im r. F.

Rear: Iupiter sitzt auf einem Thron nach l. Er hält eine ihn bekränzende Victoria auf seiner r. Hand und ein Zepter in der l. Hand.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.
