Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Severus Alexander mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Liberalitas steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Sie hält ein Rechenbrett (abacus) in ihrer r. Hand und ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae) im l. Arm.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
