## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Claudius Gothicus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r. Graffito im r. F.

Rear: Pax steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Sie hält einen Zweig in ihrer erhobenen r. Hand und ein Zepter im l. Arm schräg vor den Körper.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.
