## Description

Front: Panzerbüste des Aurelianus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r. Aegis an der l. Schulter.

Rear: Fides steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Sie hält in jeder Hand ein Feldzeichen (signum).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
