Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Gordianus III. mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r. Oben Graffito x.

Rear: Liberalitas steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. Sie hält eine Rechenbrett (abacus) in ihrer r. Hand und ein Füllhorn (cornucopiae) im l. Arm.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Pecked: Marks made by pointed instrument (e.g. a knife) onto the surface of the coin.
