Description

Front: Drapierte Büste mit diademierter Flügelkrone nach rechts.

Rear: Feueraltar flankiert von zwei Assistenzfiguren. Rechts das Münzstättenkürzel DA, links Jahr 43 (= 663/664 n. Chr.).

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
