Description

Front: Drapierte Büste der Manlia Scantilla in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Iuno steht nach l. Sie hält in der r. Hand eine Schale (patera) und im l. Arm ein Zepter. Zu ihren Füßen l. ein Pfau.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
