## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des L. Verus in der Rückenansicht nach r.

Rear: Armenia sitzt mit Bogen und Köcher vor einem Siegesmal (tropaeum) nach l.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
