Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Lucius Verus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r.

Rear: Victoria nach l. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand einen Kranz und im l. Arm einen Palmzweig.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Scratched: One or more scratches, intentional or unintentional. Can be the result of recovery or subsequent handling of a coin or medal.
