Description

Front: Drapierte Büste der Iulia Domna in der Brustansicht nach r. Im r. F. unten ein ovaler Gegenstempel, darauf ein Büste mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Reiter (Pionis?) auf einem Pferd nach r. Vor ihm ein Baum, um den sich eine Schlange windet.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
