## Description

Front: Standardisiertes Khusro II-Profil mit Flügelkrone der dritten Serie nach rechts. Als Brustornament zwei Perlen. Umrandet von doppeltem, gezackten Kreis. Als Randzier dreimal Halbmond-Stern-Ornament.

Rear: Feueraltar beidseitig flankiert von Altardienern. Feld von dreifachem Linienkreis umrandet. Als Randzier vier Halbmond-Stern-Ornamente wechselnd mit vier mal drei Perlen im Dreieck.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Plugged/repared: Refilling a hole pieced into the object or repair of any defect or other alteration e.g. adhering a crack in a coin.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
