Description

Front: Kopf der Athena mit attischem Helm nach r. Skylla wirft Stein nach r. auf dem Helmkessel.

Rear: Stier stoßend mit gesenktem Kopf, erhobenem Vorderbein nach r. Über dem Stier ΣAM. Im Abschnitt AM und ein Löwe nach r.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
