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## Description

Front: Umlaufend Nennung von Nominal, Münzstätte und Prägejahr. Im Feld das Glaubensbekenntnis. Als Randzier drei gezackte Perlkreise erkennbar. Prägejahr 91 AH.  
Rear: Umlaufend Koranzitat 9:33. Feld mit Koranzitat 112:1-4. Als Randzier ein Perlkreis. Feld von Perlkreis eingefasst.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Graffito: Lettering or similar mark incised into the surface of a coin that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin.

Eye/loop removed: A previously attached loop has been removed.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
