Front: Kopf des Asandros mit Diadem nach r.

Rear: Nike mit Kranz in der erhobenen r. Hand und einem Palmzweig in der gesenkten l. Hand auf einem Schiffsbug (prora) nach l. Im l. F. innen die Jahresangabe ΘΚ (= 29).

Pecked: Marks made by pointed instrument (e.g. a knife) onto the surface of the coin.
