## Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Severus Alexander mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r. Im r. F. über dem Ende der Umschrift eingeschlagen die Wertzahl XLII.

Rear: Mars steht mit Speer und Schild in Rüstung nach r. Beiderseits S- C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
