Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Theodosius II. mit Diadem in der Brustansicht nach r.

Rear: Siegesmal (tropeaum), beiderseits je ein Stern.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
