Description

Front: Dreizeilige Wertangabe II / KREUTZ/ER. Am Beginn der Umschrift eine Rosette. Im Feld ein Gegenstempel mit dem Straßburger Stadtschild.

Rear: Am Beginn der Umschrift eine Rosette. Im Feld ein Gegenstempel mit einem Kreuz. Siebenzeilige Aufschrift.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
