Description

Front: Kopf des Vespasianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Kybele sitzt mit einer Schale (phiale) in ihrer r. Hand auf einem Thron nach l. Zu ihren Füßen l. ein Löwe. Oben eine Punze.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
