## Description

Front: Gefäß (rhyton) in Form eines geflügelten Pferdevorderteils (protome) nach r. Runder Gegenstempel.

Rear: Tanne in Linienquadrat. Im l. F. ein Blitzbündel. Runder Gegenstempel mit dem Vorderteil (protome) eines geflügelten Pferdes (Pegasos) nach l.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
