Description

Front: Drapierte Büste des Galba mit Lorbeerkranz in der Brustansicht nach r. Im r. F. eingeschlagen die Wertzahl LXXXIII.

Rear: Libertas steht in der Vorderansicht, den Kopf nach l. gewandt. Sie hält in der l. Hand einen Stab und in der r. Hand eine Kappe (pileus). Beiderseits S - C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
