Description

Front: Kopf des Domitianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Davor die eingeschlagene Wertzahl XLII.

Rear: Spes steht nach l. In ihrer erhobenen r. Hand hält sie eine Blüte. Beiderseits S - C.

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
