Description

Front: Kopf der Demeter mit Ährenkranz nach r. Darauf ein runder Gegenstempel mit dem Kopf der Athena mit korinthischem Helm nach r.?

Rear: Mohnkapsel im unten gebundenen Ährenkranz.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
