Description

Front: Nach l. gerichtetes Löwenvorderteil (protome). Die l. Vorderpfote sichtbar, r. ein Thunfisch. Mittig eine Punze.

Rear: Vertieftes, viergeteiltes Quadrat (Quadratum incusum).

Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
