Description

Front: Kopf des Apollon mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Zwei runde Gegenstempel mit bzw. Maus und Stern.

Rear: Weidendes Pferd nach l. Unten ein Monogramm. Im Abschnitt ein Blitzbündel. Unten r. ein Gegenstempel mit einer Leier (kithara).

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
