Description

Front: Drapierte Büste des Theodahat mit Spangenhelm in gotischer Tracht nach rechts.

Rear: Victoria mit Palmzweig und Kranz auf Schiffsbug nach rechts. Beiderseits S - C.

Re-cut/tooled: Parts of the image or inscription of a coin, medal or token have been recut and potentially changed. Not to be confused with a die having been re-cut.

Field smoothed: The field of a coin or medal has secondarily been fully or partly deepened in order to improve the relief of the legend or image. This procedure occurs especially with collectors' objects and is not part of the working process of a mint. Not to be confused with the re-cutting of parts of the design or legend on a coin, or the erasure of elements of them.
