Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Maiorianus mit Helm und Diadem in der Brustansicht nach rechts. In der verdeckten linken Hand hält er einen Rundschild mit Kreuz darauf und mit der rechten Hand einen Speer schräg nach vorn.

Rear: Kreuz im Kranz.

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
