Description

Front: Wappenschild (Hochstift Verden) in Kartusche. Am Ende der Umschrift das Münzmeisterzeichen dreiblättriges Kleeblatt (Julius Bilderbeck).

Rear: Reichsapfel mit Wertzahl Z4.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
