## Description

Front: Das behelmte Wappen der Grafschaft Lippe samt Helmdecken und Helmzier (Feld 1 und 4 Lippe, 2 und 3 Schwalenberg).

Rear: Bekrönter Reichsadler. Auf der Brust ein Reichsapfel mit der Wertzahl 1Z (1 Schilling = 12 Pfennig).

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
