Description

Front: Drapierte Panzerbüste des Gallienus mit Lorbeerkranz in der Rückenansicht nach r.

Rear: Herakles im Ringkampf mit Antaios. Zwischen den Beinen des Herakles das Wertzeichen H.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.

Gilded: With an overlay (wholly or in parts) of a thin layer of gold. Process is not part of the regular production.
