No. of pendants: 12, 6 with secondaries

Groups: 2 x 6 pendants (one with and one without secondaries)

Colors: tans

Color combinations: monochrome

Strings: main, pendants, secondaries

Ply: S

Diameter: main 3,5mm, pendants 2-2,3mm

Recto/verso (tying pendant to mainstring) Hard to tell. The mainstring is closed at both ends.

Knots: 1/1 endknots (like a single knot), 1/2 endknots (a single knot securing the pendant tied with only part of the pendant as active), long knots (Z), single knots (Z)

At one end of mainstring is a "placemaker" -i.e. a two cm short yarn inserted into the main.
