Groups: irregular

Colors: tans

Color combinations: monochrome, speckled, spiral, spliced (one)

Strings: main, pendants, secondaries, tertiaries (2)

Ply: all S

Diameter: pendants 0,9 - 2,7mm

Recto/verso (tying pendant to mainstring): one group of 2 x 4 is opposite to all the others. (as it is a fragmented main, it is not possible to state R/V.

Knots: 1/1 endknots (like a single knot), 1/2 endknots (a single knot securing the pendant tied with only part of the pendant as active), 8, long knots (S), single knots (S)

8-knot above long knot. 2 long knots on one strand.
