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Description

The men's hair ornament is made of mithun bone (local buffalo species) with dyed goat hair. Borduaria is listed as the place of origin. The area is in Arunachal Pradesh, and the ethnic groups now refer to themselves as Wancho, Nocte and Konyak Naga.
