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Description

This narrow sash, made of woven and dyed cloth with fringed ends, was worn by men. The ethnic group, then called Namzik Naga, are now known as Wancho, Nocte or Konyak Naga in present-day Arunachal Pradesh. The name Namzik Naga is no longer in use.
