### Warrior basket

Warrior basket used for rituals associated with headhunting

The basket is used by men in headhunting rituals. It is made of a bamboo weave and decorated with tufts of grass. The three stylized wooden heads are decorated with red, black and white goat hair and symbolise headhunting.
