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Description

Front: Die beiden Schutzpatrone von Salzburg, St. Rupert und St. Virgil, neben dem Dom zu Salzburg, darunter Engelsköpfe in Wolken, Salzgefäß und Kirchenmodell.

Rear: Erzbischofshut über Wappenschild, beiderseits 16-55.

Looped: Modified with a loop fixed secondarily to a coin, for example in order for it to be suspended from a necklace.

Mounted: Mounted in such a way that the coin or medal has become part of a new object.
