Front: Böotischer Schild. Gammaförmige Punze.
Rear: Herakles nach r. gewandt beim Spannen seines Bogens, davor Keule, die mit dem verdicktem Ende auf der Standlinie steht.
Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
