Front: Kopf des Augustus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r. Auf der Wange eine Punze R.
Rear: Viersäuliger Rundtempel, darin Triumphwagen mit aufgestellter Deichsel nach r.
Darüber Legionsadler (aquila) nach r. und vier kleine nach r. galoppierende Pferde.
Punched: Intentionally marked with a punch, both contemporary to the object and later. In contrast to a countermark of a much more simple design. Not to be confused with punches creating a positive image, which were used during the manufacture of a die.
