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Description

Front: Jahreszahl, Landesname und Wertzahl in drei Zeilen.

Rear: Zwischen Strahlen die Zahl 19, dem Tag des Beginn des Aufstandes am 19. April 1810.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
