Front: Kopf des Galba nach r.
Rear: Nike auf Schiffsbug (prora) nach l. Sie hält in ihrer r. Hand einen Kranz und im l. Arm einen Palmzweig. Im r. F. ovaler Gegenstempel mit ΔΗΜΟ.
Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
