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Description

Front: Kopf des Herakles mit Löwenfellexuvie nach r. Auf dem Löwenfell ein rechteckiger Gegenstempel mit Anker.

Rear: Zeus Aetophoros sitzt auf einem Hocker (diphros) nach l., in der l. Hand ein Zepter. Im l. F. ΑΣ, darunter ΚΑ.

Looped: Modified with a loop fixed secondarily to a coin, for example in order for it to be suspended from a necklace.

Countermarked: The impression left by a countermark punch. A tool that is used to punch into a coin subsequent to the original striking an additional mark or symbol that had meaning in the contemporary context of the coin - for example to mark a specific payment or to revalue a coin). Objects from early modern collections sometimes bear countermarks as a sign of ownership.
