White muslin petticoat. Robe of checkered coloured muslin, with chemise front, short sleeves, trimmed all round with white fringe. Full ruff of plaited lace round the neck. Green gloves. Fawn-coloured shoes.

The front hair cut short; the hind hair turned up close. Turban bonnet of yellow cane, ornamented with a wreath of artificial flowers, a small tufted feather and a rosette. Round dress of Scotch cambric with an embroidered border; short sleeves. Black court cloak, trimmed with broad lace. Festoon necklace. Gold ear-rings. Yellow gloves and shoes.
